The implementation of SMART Board® interactive whiteboards and SMART Notebook® software has also yielded great benefits for teachers, who can now modify lesson plans to ensure a rich and interactive experience in which students from varying levels of understanding can participate. "The dynamic within the classroom has changed completely, with students now wanting to be active participants, and we can structure our lesson plans to enable them to do so," stated Stephen Michalic, Secondary Mathematics Teacher: "One of the greatest advantages is that we can cater to a wide range of levels - take math for example. Using the SMART Notebook recording features in my Math lesson, students can replay what happened in class and solve problems at their own pace. This would not have been possible previously and is just one example of how the adoption of technological advancements has benefited our students. It helps them better understand complex conceptual mathematical concepts".

Another example is the effective use of the Lesson Activity Tool Kit in the Arabic classroom. It helps produce engaging and interactive lessons that creates a 'mind active' rather than a 'mind passive' learning environment. And students organize their thinking process better.
